### EXERCISE 1:

*How many total classes are used in the OCLC dataset?*

**ANSWER: 55**

**QUERY: `get_classes.rq`**

### EXERCISE 2:

*How many total properties are used in the OCLC dataset?*

**ANSWER: 71**

**QUERY: `get_properties.rq`**

### EXERCISE 3:

*How many books written in French are there in the OCLC dataset?*

**ANSWER: 37205**

**QUERY: `french_books.rq`**

### **EXERCISE 3:**

*How many books written in French are translations of works written in other languages?*

**ANSWER: 644**

**QUERY: french\_trans.rq**

### **EXERCISE 4:**

*How many people in the dataset are “baby boomers”? HINT: “Baby boomers” is a term used to describe the generation born after WWII, usually between the years 1946 and 1964.*

**ANSWER: 7181**

**QUERY: baby\_boomers.rq OR baby\_boomers\_count.rq**

### **EXERCISE 5:**

*How many DVDS are in the OCLC dataset?*

**ANSWER: 597**

**QUERY: dvd\_count.rq**

## **EXERCISE 6:**

*What languages have Braille versions of resources available in the dataset?*

NOTE: Uses regex()

ANSWER: Danish, German, English, Spanish, French, Japanese

**QUERY: `braille_books.rq`**
